



Swine

Did you know?

Bacon, ham and pork chops all come from pigs.

A pig can run a mile in seven minutes averaging a top speed of about 11 miles per hour.

Pigs have more taste buds than humans. A pig has 15,000 taste buds while humans only have 9,000.

Learn the terms

Pig: generic term, usually refers to immature (teenage) swine

Hog: generic term, usually applied to growing swine

Gilt: young female swine; has not produced a litter

Sow: Mother pig; has 2 or 3 litters per year with 8-15 piglets per litter

Piglet: a baby

A group of these animals is called a **sounder**.





Cow: An adult female dairy animal that has delivered a calf, usually around 2 years of age

Heifer: A young female dairy animal that has yet to give birth to a calf


A group of these animals can be called a **drift**, **drove**, **herd** or **mob**.


